ALL Classes will qualify for the ElandLodge.com Hunter Trials Championships 2021

Class 1A Junior Intermediate

Riders not to have attained 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Combination not to have represented and completed a Riding Club or Pony Club at Cross Country/Horse Trials (One Day Event) or have completed a BE Horse Trials at a level greater than BE90.

Approximately 90cm - 1m in height.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 90cm

Class 1B Senior Intermediate

Riders 18 and over on 1st January in the current year. Combination and heights as for Class 1A.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 90cm

Class 2A Junior OPEN Intermediate

Riders not to have attained 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. This Class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 1A but still wishing to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 90cm

Class 2B Senior OPEN Intermediate

Riders 18 and over on 1st January in the current year. This Class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 1B but still wishing to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 90cm

Class 3A Junior Novice

Riders not to have attained 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Combination not to have been placed in any Cross Country/Horse Trials (One Day Event) other than Novice or Starters and not to have won a Novice competition. Combination not to have represented and completed a Riding Club or Pony Club at Cross Country/Horse Trials (One Day Event) or have completed a BE Horse Trials at a level greater than BE80.

Approximately 75cm - 85cm in height.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 80cm

Class 3B Senior Novice

Riders 18 and over on 1st January in the current year. Combination and heights as for Class 3A.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 80cm

Class 4A Junior OPEN Novice

Riders not to have attained 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. This Class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 3A but still wishing to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 80cm

Class 4B Senior OPEN Novice

Riders 18 and over on 1st January in the current year. This Class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 3B but still wishing to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 80cm

Class 5A Junior Starters.

Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Combination not to have been placed in any Cross Country/ Horse Trials (One Day Event) competition. Combination not to

have represented a Riding Club or Pony Club at Cross Country/Horse Trials(One Day Event) and not to have competed at BE in any class. **Approximately 60cm - 70cm in height.**

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 50cm

Class 5B Senior Starters.

Riders 18 and over on the 1st of January in the current year. Combination and heights as for Class 5A.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 50cm

Class 6A Junior OPEN Starters.

Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday on 1st January in the current year. This class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 5A, but still wish to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 50cm

Class 6B Senior OPEN Starters.

Riders 18 or over on the 1st January in the current year. This class is aimed at Riders not eligible for Class 5B, but still wish to compete at that level.

Qualifier for ElandLodge.com National Hunter Trials - 50cm

Entry fee: £15 for members and £25 for non-members.

Plus £5 per rider for First Aid

Number of fences, length of course, course plan, optimum time, coursewalk times, and times for all classes will be communicated with the start times. There will be no WRC bibs available. You must provide your own paper numbers. No Stopwatches Allowed. All classes are open to Non-Members.

Notes

1. Protective headgear to the current standard (No fixed peak hats), body protectors to current standard must be worn on cross country course and medical armbands are strongly recommended.
2. Course will be 'open flagged' (with the exception of the Starters), i.e. if you wish to jump the larger fences, providing you are between the red and white flags, you will not incur any penalties.
3. No Stopwatches Allowed for the Cross Countries.
4. No Horse/ Pony may compete in more than one class on the same day.
5. Competitors having a fall, in any phase, may not remount or continue until they have been checked by a First Aider. A fall on the Cross Country course will incur elimination. It is recommended to be checked by a First Aider before leaving the Showground.
6. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes/sections.
7. If your times are not on the website, please contact the organiser, NOT AFTER 9.30 PM.
8. In the event of cancellation, all entries will be refunded less a small administration charge.
9. Stallions: Stallions must be led from a bit with reins or with a lead rope of a minimum length of 2.5m. A stallion disc must be displayed on each side of a stallion's bridle at all times. No person may bring a stallion to a competition without ensuring, at all times, that competitors, ponies/horses and members of the public are not put at risk. (BRC Rule G25)

Wilmslow Riding Club – Conditions for Cross Country 26th July 2020

Important - Do not enter the show ground if you or anyone you have been in contact with is showing signs of Covid-19

1. Remember to bring your number/bib – we cannot provide a bib or the number to go inside it on the day if you forget.
2. On arrival the gate steward will check the rider is on the list of competitors. If there are helper(s) not travelling with the rider please give their car registration to the steward.
3. Only one helper per horse, in addition to the rider. If the rider is under 12, or disabled, one extra helper is allowed. **No one else may enter the show ground.**
4. You will be told where to park, 5 metres apart, tying up on the left side. Cars (not towing) will be parked by the pavilion, not with the wagons/trailers.
5. Please stay with your wagon / trailer when not competing or using the facilities. No congregating anywhere on the show ground.
6. There is a one-way system in place for horses and pedestrians. You must use it.
7. Remember social distancing at all times, mounted or on foot. Sanitisers will be at the collecting ring and at the start, by the toilets and by the pavilion. Hand washing facilities will be by the tap (near the toilets). Please use these regularly.
8. The secretary, Hazel, may be contacted by text or phone on 07774204284. **She cannot make any alterations or take entries on the day.** Please contact her if you have a problem. You will be texted any extra information you may need on the day.
9. You may not have your helper in the collecting ring, only five riders at a time. The steward in this ring will adjust the fences for you. Because of the limit on numbers, please do not enter the collecting ring until it is your turn.
10. Course Walking – You may walk the course on the Saturday prior to the event after 2pm. You may NOT walk the course whilst a class is taking place. Times for course walks will be posted along with competitors' start times.
11. As soon as you have completed your round and washed your horse/pony off please leave.
12. Results will be posted on Horsemonkey, FaceBook and our website, www.wilmslowridingclub.cu.uk.
13. Rosettes will be sent out 24 hours after the results are posted.

For this show to take place and be Covid compliant, all these conditions must be strictly adhered to. Members of the Committee will be on site in high viz jackets if you need more information.
